### CRWRF – Indonesian Tsunami

On December 22 a tsunami triggered by the eruption of Anak Krakatau hit large coastal areas of the Sunda Strait (between Java and Sumatra, Indonesia) causing loss of life and significant destruction. The latest reports count the death toll at 437, and the number of displaced at over 33,000. The scope of the food and non-food emergency needs is immediate.

CRWRF is currently responding (in the amount of \$20,000) by partnering with our connection in Timor, Indonesia, (New Hope Foundation) to provide assistance. Working with New Hope food packages & baby care packages will be distributed to those in need.

If you wish to help, we will gratefully accept your donations. All donations specific to the tsunami should be earmarked "Indonesian Tsunami" and they will be directed to our relief response. Monies for this should be received by February 28th – funds received after this will be placed into our general fund. All cheques should be made payable to "CRWRF", and mailed to CRWRF, P.O. Box 85225, Burlington, ON L7R 4K4.
