Thousands were injured and killed on that first day of the invasion of Europe. Some died in the water in a hail of German gunfire, and never even made it to shore. But, the biggest naval landing in history was a success, and Hitler's German Reich collapsed like a house of cards less than a year later. Canadian troops played a very important part in the Liberation of the Netherlands. And that explains why we are here today. Many Dutch people felt grateful and still feel thankful to Canada. Many responded by coming to Canada and settling in to stay. So, we bow our heads and say thank you to all those who sacrificed their lives for the freedoms we cherish. And, we look up and say thank you to our Almighty God for his amazing wisdom and providence in providing us with a beautiful country to live in. Thanks be to God!

We may also rejoice with our friends Kanchan and Farhat Mohajan. The good news is that they officially became Canadian citizens on May 28th. Congratulations to you both, and especially also to the children, Isaac, Joshua, and Keziah. May the Lord bless you with much success and happiness as you seek to become a blessing to Canada and to your church community, and as we seek to continue to be a blessing to you.

We can give thanks once more with Jacob Bredenhof. His mother, Tracey has posted a last very thankful message on her blog. She

thanked the Lord that Jacob has been declared free of cancer. There were four important and special words: "No evidence of disease". That was the verdict after all the scans were done.
