Short Report of the Council Meeting June 11, 2019

1. The Chairman, br. Henry Voorhorst, opened the meeting with reading Revelation 10 and prayer.
2. Attendance: All brothers were present. Br. George Gunnink, member of the Calling Committee, was in attendance during the Calling Committee portion of the meeting.
3. The agenda was adopted as presented.
4. The Calling Committee presented their report to Council. Council discussed the findings of the Calling Committee and decided unanimously to present a new name to the congregation. A congregational meeting will be held on June 16 after the morning worship service to approve a motion to extend a call.
5. Br. George Gunnink closed this portion of the meeting in prayer.
6. The meeting continued with the next point: review of the election of office bearers.
7. Council discussed how to go forward without a full complement of office bearers. After some discussion, Council decided to table the election of one additional office bearer until after the transition of new office bearers has taken place on June 17th.
8. Question period was used. A couple of information items were discussed.
9. Christian censure: Opportunity was given, but not used.
10. The next Council meeting is the transition meeting, which is scheduled for June 17, 2019 at 7:30pm
11. Closing: We sang Hymn 8 and br. Ken VanderPloeg closed in prayer.
